# Conflict, Peace and Security (UOC, UNITAR)

The Master's Degree in Conflict, Peace and Security is a unique opportunity designed to enhance the understanding of conflicts in all their dimensions and to explore innovative approaches to their management, resolution and transformation with the help of world-leading academics and experts. Built on the combined expertise of the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR) and Universitat Oberta de Catalunya (UOC), the Master's programme in Conflict, Peace and Security aims to equip participants with a broad analytical skillset, first-hand knowledge and unique expertise from the field of conflict, peace & security studies.

## Objectives

- To learn about the nature of contemporary conflicts.
- To acquire the skills to analyse and plan peaceful interventions and on the prevention and transformation of conflicts.
- To learn techniques and strategies for intelligent and nonviolent intervention in conflict situations.
- To understand security paradigms (both traditional and human security) and how they are linked to conflict situations.
- To be able to lead and facilitate negotiation and mediation processes.
- To transform the way we communicate, both to prevent and to resolve conflicts.

## Competences

- Critical analysis of complex conflict situations.
- Understanding of the overall concept of conflict resolution, its terminology, action criteria, and techniques and methods specific to it.
- Analysis of armed conflicts and how to manage them, transform them and resolve them using non-violent intervention strategies, techniques and resources.
- Understanding of security related aspects which should be considered when analysing conflict situations.
- Ability to development communication in ways to prevent, direct and pacify conflicts.

- Anyone interested in conflict resolution.
- Advisers, executives, managers or lawyers in all sectors.
- Civil servants and administrative staff in public and private institutions.
- Administrative staff and NGO employees who work in conflict areas, or in reconstruction, development and international cooperation projects in such areas.
- Graduates of political sciences, international relations, and conflict, peace & security studies.
- Politicians and diplomatic.
- Military personnel and police.
